Gentlemen:

Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (or Lots 10, 11, 12, 13) of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Aztec-Hanks No. 2 Well, located 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, was completed August 1, 1949 as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on April 24, 1950.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 187.23 acres which are contiguous lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That so far as is known to Applicant, the following companies constitute the only operators, other than Applicant, owning an interest in any of the acreage included in or offsetting the proposed unit, and such companies are being notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit by the mailing of a copy of this application to each of them:

El Paso Natural Gas Company	El Paso, Texas
Three States Natural Gas Company	Corrigan Tower Dallas 1, Texas



Therefore, Aztec Oil & Gas Company respectfully requests that under the provisions of Rule 6(b) of Order No. R-565, as amended, the Secretary of the Commission grant an exception to Rule 6(a), without notice and hearing, approving the non-standard gas proration unit hereinabove requested.


