Dear Mr. Selinger:

Order R-1018 added acreage to the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County. Included in the acreage was Section 31-25N-3W.

Due to erroneous survey the #3 McConnell well was originally located in the Southeast quarter of Section 31, which contains 160 acres. When the survey was corrected the location was shown to be in the Southwest quarter of the Section, which contains 178.93 acres.

We did not note the change in acreage; therefore our records indicated that the #3 well was located in a standard quarter section and the #2 McConnell well was in a non-standard quarter section. After a further search of records we find that the #2 McConnell is in the Southeast quarter of Section 31-25N-3W. Such quarter contains 160 acres, being a standard quarter section. The #3 McConnell is located in the Southwest quarter of Section 31-25N-3W. This quarter section contains 178.93 acres. Apparently our mistake led you to request a non-standard proration unit on August 13, 1957 for the #2 McConnell. The request should have been for the #3 McConnell, located 1157 feet from the South line and 2200 feet from the West line of Section 31-25N-3W.

We respectfully request that an amended application be submitted at your earliest opportunity. If we can be of any further assistance, please contact us.

Gentlemen:

As a result of a recent action by the Oil Conservation Commission in issuing Order No. R-1018, we have assigned 178.93 acres to Skelly Oil Company's L. L. McConnell Well No. 2 unit, letter p, in Section 31, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as a result of which this well was placed in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool.

The proposed nonstandard proration unit consists of more than 160 acres and the unorthodox size and shape of the tract is entirely due to variation of the legal subdivision of the United States public land survey. We respectfully request administrative approval for a nonstandard proration unit since it consists of contiguous quarter quarter section lying wholly within a single governmental section and is surrounded by producing gas wells. All interests in these lands are under common ownership, with Skelly Oil Company being the operator thereof. By carbon copy of this letter we are requesting waiver from the offset operators, J. Felix Hickman c/o of Jason W. Kellahin, P. O. Box 1713, Santa Fe, New Mexico and Sun Oil Company, P. O. Box 679, Durango, Colorado.


