We request approval to communitize a non-standard unit consisting of 330.04 acres, the whole W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35, T32N, R13W. This is the area developed through study of government GLO plats in the area. We have not notified any offset operator since we believe in this instance we are the only operator of interest. We have ourselves developed or plan to develop all adjacent areas to the north, south and east. From the maps and information available to us, it does not appear that any westerly development is likely.
