A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now the applicant and in support of its Application, states:

1. It is the operator of the Johnston-Federal No. 8 well located 1,090 feet from the South and West Lines of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
2. The Johnston-Federal No. 8 well was completed as a gas well in the Mesaverde Formation in February of 1956 and presently has the W/2 of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, containing 206.60 acres, attributed to it for gas allowable purposes.
3. In applicant's opinion, the proposed non-standard gas proration unit meets the requirements of Rule 1 (b) of Order No. R-128-D for the following reasons:
 - (a) The unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections and/or lots;
 - (b) The unit lies wholly within a single governmental section;
 - (c) The entire unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
4. Attached to this Application and identified as Exhibit "A" is a plat showing the acreage in the proposed unit, the location of the well and the ownership of the offset tracts.
5. Attached to this Application and identified as Exhibit "B" is an Affidavit stating that all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed non-standard proration unit is located and all operators owning interests in acreage offsetting the proposed non-standard gas proration unit have been mailed a copy of this Application by registered mail.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests administrative approval of this non-standard gas proration unit pursuant to Rule 1 (b) of Order R-128-D.


