Gentlemen:

We respectfully request that a 120 acre non-standard gas proration unit be approved, consisting of the following described acreage:

W/2 of the SE/4
SE/4 of the SE/4
Section 18, Township 29 North
Range 13 west, N.M.P.M. in San
Juan County, New Mexico
containing 120 acres, more or less,
and all being fee land.

The above described acreage to be dedicated to a well located 740 feet from the south line and 760 feet from the east line of Section 18. This well being less than one mile from the West Kutz field. The proposed dedicated acreage is less than 160 acres, is all contiguous and located wholly within one section. All of the above mentioned acreage may be presumed productive from the Pictured Cliffs formation. The remaining forty acres cannot be legally dedicated at this time under Commission rules.

All known operators owning acreage offsetting the proposed unit are being notified herewith.

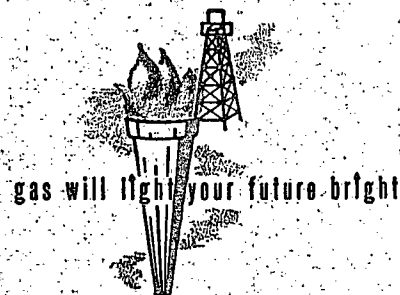

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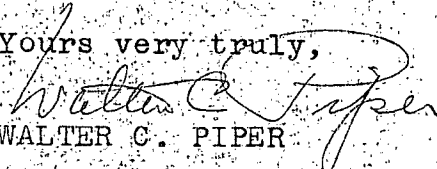
Dear Mr. Porter:

As a result of my conversation with you and your Attorneys, I am enclosing a letter requesting a 120 acre non-standard gas proration unit be formed.

As you will recall, our well, known as the Fawkes #1, was drilled to save our lease on the 120 acres, and upon word from the two owners of the remaining forty acres, that a lease would be given by them. We do have a lease for an undivided one-half interest in the forty acres, but I am informed by your Attorneys that the State cannot divide an undivided one-half interest for purposes of forming a proration unit, and the other one-half interest owner has changed his mind, and declared that he will not enter into any agreement concerning his interests.
