Dear Mr. Bruce:

Reference is made to the following:

- (a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pTGW10-23548652**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico, on behalf of **Chi Operating, Inc.** [OGRID 4378] (Chi), on August 23, 2010, and
- (b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

Chi has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox oil well location, described above in the caption of this letter. The NW/4 SE/4 of Section 1 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 40-acre spacing unit in the Benson-Delaware Pool (97083). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.9.A, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 330 feet from the southern unit boundary.

Your application on behalf of Chi has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).

It is our understanding that Chi is seeking this location to comply with United States Bureau of Land Management potash protection requirements.

It is also understood that notice of this application to offsetting operators or owners is unnecessary due to common working interest ownership.


Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
