




Under date of December 22, 1960, the Aztec Oil & Gas Company apparently filed with the Commission an application for administrative approval of a non-standard unit consisting of,



Pursuant to Rule 1(b) of Order R-1287, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its Application in triplicate for an exception to Rule 1(a) of such Order and Administrative Approval of a Non-Standard Unit consisting of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and $N\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32, T-29-N, R-11-W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

In support of this Application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. A location has been staked eight hundred and ninety feet (890') from the South line and nine hundred and ninety feet (990') from the East line of Section 32 for the proposed well to be known as the Mangum "B" No. 1 Well.
2. Applicant owns all the acreage within the non-standard unit, as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. Operators owning offsetting acreage are E. A. Hanson, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, Pubco Petroleum Corporation, Summit Oil Company and John J. Redfern, Jr., and each has been furnished a copy of this Application with a request that their consent in the form of a waiver of notice and hearing be forwarded to the Commission.
3. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections or lots.

4. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

5. The entire non-standard unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

6. The length or width of the non-standard unit does not exceed five thousand two hundred and eighty feet (5280').

Applicant respectfully requests that this Application be promptly considered and that approval be administratively granted, pursuant to Rule 1(b) of Order R-1287, for the non-standard unit above described.

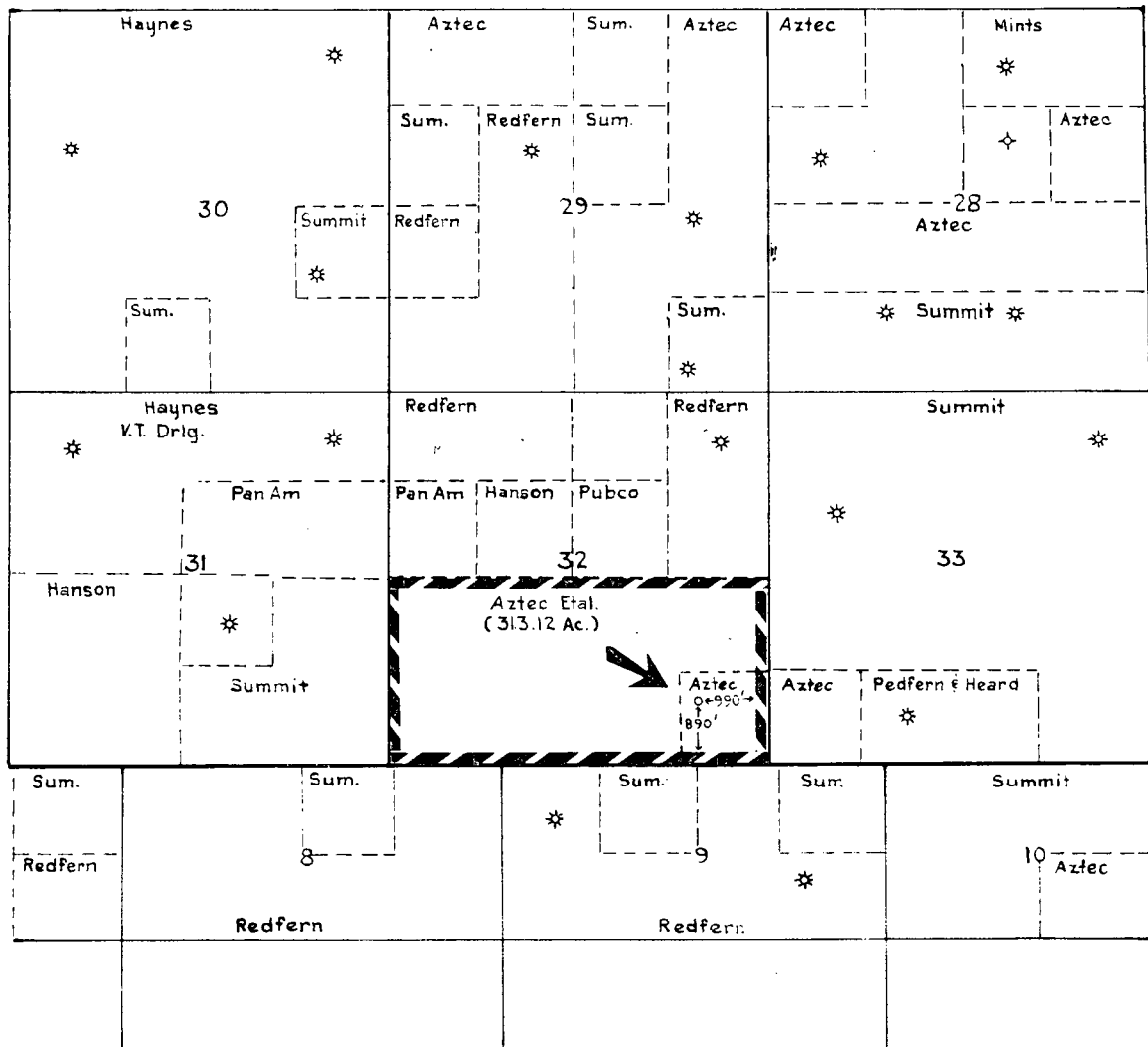


EXHIBIT "A"
