Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, N4PM  
Section 23: NE/4, W/2 SE/4 and NE/4 SE/4  
Section 24: NW/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to a well to be located in the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 23.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 (D) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-1670-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres.
