Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 92.05-acre non-standard oil proration unit in the Cha-Cha-Gallup Oil Pool consisting of the following acreage:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM
Section 30: E/2 SW/4 and Lots 3 and 4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Hagood #29-G Well, located 450 feet from the South line and 3600 feet from the East line of said Section 30.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Cha-Cha-Gallup Oil Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard oil proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 92.05 acres.

The effective date of this order shall be August 15, 1961.
