Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 367.96-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

RIO ARriba COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 31 NORTE, RANGE 5 WEST, NMPM
Section 5: Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and 8/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Rosa Unit Well No. 41, located 1500 feet from the South line and 1528 feet from the West line of said Section 5.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 367.96 acres.
