Dear Mrs. Dysart:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 333.80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 14 WEST, NMPM
Section 36: W/2, or Lots 4 and 5, N/2
SW/4, NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Pubco State Well No. 31, located 1650 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 36.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 333.80 acres.
