Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 91.50 acre non-standard oil proration unit in the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool consisting of the following acreage:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM
SECTION 31: NW/4 comprising 91.50 acres

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Callow "C" Oil Unit Well #1, located 810 feet from the North line and 890 feet from the West line of said Section 31.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 91.50 acres.
