Reference is made to your application for approval of a 135-acre non-standard gas proration unit in an undesignated Fruitland pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, NMPM

Section 29: NE/4 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4, West 25 acres
of the NW/4 NW/4, and East 30 acres
of the SW/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Clarence W. Adair Pearson Well No. 1, located 1650 feet from the North line and 1530 feet from the West line of said Section 29.

By authority granted us under the provisions of Rule 104 D II of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit.
