Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas within the Wildcat Yeso (Oil) from the following Eddy County, New Mexico wells.

Wyatt Draw North 17K Well No. 1 (API 30-015-37618) Unit K, Sec 17, 19S, 26E

Wyatt Draw North 18-19 LD Well No. 1H (API 30-015-38069)  
SHL: Unit L, 2490 feet FSL, 350 feet FWL, Sec 18, 19S, 26E  
BHL: Unit D, 990 FNL, 350 FWL, Sec 19, 19S, 26E

Commingled oil, gas and water production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Wyatt Draw North 17 K Tank Battery, located in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 17, 19S, 26E, NMPM.


All production from the wells will be sent to either the testing vessel or the production vessel. Only one well will be sent to the testing vessel at any given time. The other wells that flow to the Wyatt Draw North 17 K Tank Battery will be sent to the production vessel. The testing vessel is a three phase separator that will meter all phases prior to commingling with other producing wells. All wells will be tested for a period of no less than 3 days per month to achieve the most accurate test information.

Additional existing or future drilled wells can be added to the commingling authority granted by this order with additional applications to the Santa Fe Office of the Division and notices to all interest owners.



NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations of the Division applicable to surface commingling. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
