

Wells were immediately shut down, a vacuum truck was dispatched and all necessary valves were closed. The incident was contained within approximately 1 hr.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* An approximate size of 450' x 2' was impacted. Soil from the pooling areas was excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approx. 200', per New Mexico State Engineers Office); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 0. Based on site ground water quality and enclosed analytical results.
