Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pTGW11-02151648**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on January 21, 2011, and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

COG Operating, LLC [OGRID 229137] (COG) has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox oil well location, described above in the caption of this letter. The NW/4 NW/4 of Section 15 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Grayburg Jackson; Seven Rivers-Queen Grayburg-San Andres Pool (28509). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.9.A, which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 330 feet from the western unit boundary.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).
