

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
8" PVC slip joint broke off of the 8" inlet auto valve. All repairs on the PVC fill line have been made.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
Initially 50bbls of produced water was released from the fill line at the SWD tanks. 1bbl of the produced water was contained inside the lined facility walls. The contaminated gravel was removed and replaced with clean gravel. The other 49bbls were released outside of the dike wall and ran west of dike and off location with a total spill area of 3 yards x 150 yards. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment. On 8-2-10 at 2:30pm, a line parted at the Loco Hills SWD #1 Battery causing a spill of 50bbls of produced water. 1bbl was released into the lined dike, the rest ran west of the battery into the pasture contaminating a 6' X 450' area. No fluids were recovered due to quick soil absorption. The contaminated gravel inside the lined dike will be cleaned or replaced. We will perform no cleanup outside until instructed to do so by HSE. The line was repaired and the battery returned to service. Legal description below.
