Gentlemen:

Skelly Oil Company is now in the process of drilling a well in the Lovington Paddock Pool on its Mexico "Y" lease at a location 460' from the North line and 330' from the East line of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 36 East. This lease is a 40 acre tract confined by the boundaries of NE/4 NE/4 Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 36 East. Upon completion of this well it is our plan to connect this well and commingle the fluid therefrom with that produced on our adjoining State "Y" lease in the Lovington Paddock Pool.

The State "Y" lease is a 120 acre tract confined by the boundaries S/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SE/4 Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 36 East. The above mentioned leases concern but a single royalty owner, namely the State of New Mexico, and both are dedicated to a common beneficiary.

Upon completion of the above mentioned well, such equipment as is necessary will be installed so that accurate production tests can be taken at reasonable intervals.

A plat of this general area is attached and is accurate to the best of our knowledge.

Therefore, so that undue hardship will not be enforced, Skelly Oil Company requests that the Secretary of the Commission grant an exception to Statewide Rule 309, by which Skelly Oil Company may commingle the oil from two separate State leases.

Since this well will be completed in the near future, your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.

Exception to Rule 30⁹ (a)

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval for exception to Rule 30⁹ (a) in the Lovington Paddock Pool.

It is understood that this exception to Rule 30⁹ (a) is to be ascribed to your Mexico "Y" lease, known as State Lease No. E-2736, which is the 40-acre lease described as the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 35 and your State "R" lease, known as State Lease No. B-7766, which is the 240-acre lease described as the NW/4 and E/2 SW/4 of Section 36, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 30⁹, Section (b)-6 as set forth in Order R-645, you are hereby authorized to operate a central tank battery on the above described acreage as an exception to Rule 30⁹ (a).
