Dear Mr. Porter:

We have recently completed development on the 160-acre State WC lease in the Kemnitz Wolfcamp Field, Lea County, New Mexico, and are now initiating development on our adjoining 640-acre lease with the drilling of State WD No. 1. As is shown on the attached plat, the State WC lease (State of New Mexico E-2509) and State WD lease (State of New Mexico E-1769) are located in Sections 28 and 29, T-16S, R-34E, NMPM Survey.

We propose to centralize oil treating and storage facilities for all wells drilled on the above leases, with the unitized battery to be located as shown, at the approximate center of the NW/4 of Section 29. The substantial savings to be realized in initial tankage costs, plus additional savings in lease operating costs resulting from reduced battery maintenance, would permit us to produce these wells economically for a longer period of time, thereby increasing the amount of oil recovered from the reservoir.


We have obtained permission to this centralized tank battery proposal from the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands, and from the offset operators. The approvals from the offset operators and a copy of the Land Office approval are included with this letter.

With the preliminary work now completed, we are hereby making formal application for administrative approval to commingle the oil produced on our State WC and State WD leases into a common tank battery located on the State WC lease.
