Reference is made to your letter dated October 12, 1966, wherein you seek the amendment to Administrative Order CTB-23 to permit the commingling of Lazy J-Pennsylvanian production from your State "BV" (NCT-1) Lease comprising the W/2 of Section 26, your State "BV" (NCT-2) Lease comprising all of Section 36, your State "BY" (NCT-1) Lease comprising the E/2 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 35, and your State "BY" (NCT-2) Lease comprising the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 35, all in Township 13 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the production from the State "BV" (NCT-1 and NCT-2) Lease and the production from your State "BY" (NCT-1 and NCT-2) Lease will be separately metered prior to commingling in accordance with the requirements set forth in the October 24, 1966, and November 2, 1966, letters of the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico.

Pursuant to the authority granted me by Commission Rule 309-B, Administrative Order CTB-23 is hereby amended to permit the commingling of the above-described four tracts, with the understanding

that the remaining installation will be operated in accordance
with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation
and Operation of Comminuting Facilities," including the requirement
for non-reset counters on the meters.
