Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation herewith makes application for an exception to Rule 309 of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, requesting permission to commingle the production of oil from separate state oil and gas leases, the acreage therein being contiguous. In support of this application, Gulf Oil Corporation states the following:

- (1) The separate state leases are dedicated to a common beneficiary.
- (2) The wells are producing from a common source of supply.
- (3) No more than eight units will produce into a common tank battery, and adequate facilities will be provided for accurately determining production from each well at reasonable intervals.
- (4) All owners of adjoining oil and gas leases have been notified by registered mail of our intention to so commingle production from the above named leases.
- (5) Attached hereto, and made a part of this application, is a letter from the State Land Commissioner approving the commingling of oil from the two separate state leases.


Therefore Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests the Secretary-Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commis-
