Pursuant to request of our Mr. J. E. Lynch, this is to inform you that inasmuch as our company's 1/16 of 8/8 overriding royalty interest is uniform throughout the captioned acreage (the exact depth limitation of the State "A" Farm lands being dependent upon the total depth of the No. 1 well and will be determined upon completion) we have no objection to the commingling of production from these properties providing, of course, that such commingling meets with the approval of the other interested parties.


Further, in the event the commingling is effected, we will appreciate your furnishing our Accounting Department copies of the monthly production reports for these properties.

Our records indicate that the State Farm No. 1 well was completed as an oil well late in July, 1958, and this is to inquire when we may expect to receive a covering division order for execution on behalf of our company. It may be that the division order has been delayed pending the outcome of the State "A" No. 1 well so that in the event of commingling both properties could be covered on the initial division order, and your advice in this regard will be appreciated.
