Reference is made to your application dated November 3, 1960, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission to permit the commingling of the oil produced from the following described State of New Mexico oil and gas leases in the Langlie-Mattix Pool to-wit:

MATTIX LEASE, W/2 NW/4 AND E/2 SW/4 OF SECTION 2

CHAM-MATTIX LEASE, E/2 NW/4 OF SECTION 2
all in TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 309 (b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, I hereby authorize you to commingle the production from the above-described leases from the Langlie-Mattix Pool in a common tank battery.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as authorizing the production of more than sixteen wells into a single tank battery.
