Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 3, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission to permit the commingling of the oil produced from the following described State of New Mexico oil and gas leases in the Gallegos-Gallup Pool, to-wit:

Federal SF 078391-A Lease comprising the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 25 and Federal SF 078391 Lease comprising the NE/4 of Section 36, all in Township 27 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 309 (b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, I hereby authorize you to commingle the production from the above described leases from the Gallegos-Gallup Pool in a common tank battery.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as authorizing the production of more than sixteen wells into a single tank battery.
