Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application, dated October 9, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303(a) and Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

It is my understanding that you propose to drill two oil wells each producing from the Brinkard, McNea and Ellenburger Pools, one well to be drilled on your State "JM" Lease comprising the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and the other well to be drilled on your State "JP" Lease comprising the NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 2, that you propose to commingle the production from both wells after it has been metered through a separator for each zone, that the production will be allocated to each well on the basis of monthly well tests, that the production from each zone in both wells will be continuously metered, and that the commingling installation is to be located on the said State "JM" Lease.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303(b) and Rule 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as outlined in your application and in the paragraph above; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
