Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 21, 1961, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the Andersen Ranch-Wolfsamp Pool production from your State "B" No. 1-28 Well (Lease No. E-5368) and State "B" No. 2-33 Well (Lease No. E-5667) located in Sections 28 and 33, Township 15 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, into a common tank battery without first separately metering the production from each lease.

By the authority vested in me under Rule 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, I hereby authorize you to commingle the production from the above-described leases from the Andersen Ranch-Wolfsamp Pool into a common tank battery; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
