Reference is made to your application, dated February 9, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the Vacuum-San Andres Pool production from your State Leases B-2229 and B-2148 located in Sections 25, 26, 35, and 36, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, MHPN, Lea County, New Mexico.

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
In further support of this application, Phillips Petroleum Company states the following:
