Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 23, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of the South Vacuum Devonian Pool production from your Reeves and Reeves "A" Leases located in Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the ownership of both leases is identical throughout and that production will be attributed to each lease on the basis of periodic well tests.

By the authority vested in me under Rule 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, I hereby authorize you to commingle the production from the above-described leases from the South Vacuum Devonian Pool in a common tank battery; provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." Monthly well tests shall be taken for the purpose of allocating production.
