Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the application of Kern County Land Company for authority to commingle East Saunders Permo-Pennsylvanian production from its Etcheverry Unit Well Nos. 1, 2, and 3 with East Saunders production from the Etcheverry Unit Well No. 4, after separately metering the production from Well No. 4 and the composite production from the other three wells. These metering facilities shall include temperature compensated positive displacement meters and strainers and samplers and are required inasmuch as there is a variation in the beneficiary royalty ownership in the acreage dedicated to Wells Nos. 1, 2, and 3 and that dedicated to Well No. 4.

We have now received the consent of the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico and the consent of Pan American Petroleum Corporation, purchaser of the crude oil, to the aforesaid commingling installation.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-3, Kern County Land Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.

SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO

Under the authority granted as herein set forth in 005-B, Kern County and Company is hereby authorized to construct the above-described production well as proposed subject to the provisions of the Commission. Should the the Installation and Operation of Production Facilities, including the requirements for non-reset controls on the system. It is noted that the District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.

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Administrative Order CTB-84, which previously authorized the comingling of production from Wells Nos. 1, 2, and 3, is hereby rescinded.
