Dear Mr. Halvorsen:

As a follow-up to our telephone conversation today, this will confirm that Continental is agreeable to the purchase of production from the two portions of your "Trust" Lease on a commingled basis.

This lease is described as follows:

Lease No. NM-04361 consisting of the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 27, T-16S, R-31-E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico

Lease No. NM-05186 consisting of the SE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 27, T-16-S, R-31-E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.



We have your letter of January 15, 1962, in which you have outlined your plan to commingle production from Trust Well No. 1, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T-16-S, R-31-E, on Federal Lease NM 05186 and Federal No. 4 Well, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T-16-S, R-31-E, on Federal Lease NM 04361.
