Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated July 10, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A to permit the commingling of oil produced from your State B-1167 lease comprising the E/2 NW/4 of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 34 East and your State B-1400 lease comprising the W/2 NW/4 of Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, Wilson Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the ownership of each lease is common throughout and that the state land beneficiary under each lease is identical.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of periodic well tests, and subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
