**Reference is made to your letter of April 11, 1963, requesting an amendment to the above-referenced orders to permit the commingling of Wolfcamp production from your J. R. Thompson Lease, North Eagley Field, Lea County, New Mexico, with Wolfcamp production from your Humble State and your State "L" Leases, and Upper Pennsylvanian production from your State "M" Lease, after separately metering the production from each pool and from each lease.**

**Pending receipt of a schematic diagram detailing the manner in which these various sources of production are being commingled, temporary authority until June 15, 1963, is hereby granted. It is expected that at that time a new order will be issued covering all commingling activity by Cabot in this field and superseding the subject Administrative Orders which have now been amended on several occasions.**

Reference is made to your letter of December 3, 1962 wherein you request an amendment to combination administrative order PC-102 CTR-91 as amended by our letter of December 3, 1962.

In our understanding that your John A. Thompson Well No. 1 has been completed in the Upper Pennsylvanian formation rather than in the Wolfcamp formation and that you wish the aforesaid administrative orders to authorize drilling Upper Pennsylvanian protection from acid well rather than Wolfcamp protection.

It is noted that PC-102 CTR-91 is a combination order.
