Dear Mr. Porter:

I respectfully request permission to commingle the production from my Western Lease with the production from my Western "C" Lease. Photocopy of my letter of approval for this installation from the USGS is attached.

In accordance with your Rule 309-B, this application is submitted in triplicate. A plat showing the location of the wells on the leases and the formations in which they are completed is enclosed along with a schematic diagram of the commingling facility. All production is from a common source of supply, the Pearl Queen Field. Any wells can be tested at any time and I propose to calibrate the meter quarterly to satisfy the USGS. All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production are being notified of my intent to commingle by copy of this application by certified mail today.

The ownership of the leases is common throughout including working interest ownership, royalty ownership and overriding royalty ownership.

If anything further is required to obtain approval, please advise.


