Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 20, 1962, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your State Lease B-1861 comprising the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 29, B-2073 comprising the NE/4 of Section 29, B-2224 comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 21, B-2264 comprising the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 21, B-2388 comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 20, and B-2498 comprising the N/2 NW/4 and SW/4 NW/4 of Section 28, all in Township 17 South, Range 35 East, with oil produced from Phillips Chemical Company State Lease B-2264 comprising the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is understood that the ownership of all of the Phillips Petroleum Company leases is identical and that inasmuch as Phillips Chemical Company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Phillips Petroleum Company, this lease may also be considered common ownership. You therefore propose to allocate the Vacuum Pool production on the basis of well tests rather than separate measurement of the production.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
