Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 14, 1962 for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your State "BL" lease and your Lane lease comprising the W/2 NW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 14, and the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 14 respectively, Township 10 South, Range 32 East, Mescalero San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico after separately metering the production from each lease.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-D, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
