Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of November 20, 1963, to Mr. Joe Ramey, Supervisor of the Hobbs District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, wherein you state that you will no longer commingle the oil produced from your State "BL" Lease and your Lane Lease comprising the W/2 NW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 14 and the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 14, respectively, Township 10 South, Range 32 East, Mescalero-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as authorized under Administrative Order CTB-99. Instead, individual tanks will now be used for each lease, all tanks being located at a common battery site on the State "BL" Lease.

Administrative Order CTB-99 is herewith cancelled, and off-lease storage facilities are hereby authorized for the Lane Lease, provided, however, that there shall be no inter-communication of the handling, separating, treating, or storage facilities designated to each lease.
