Administrative Order CTB-100

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 27, 1962 for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your Phillips lease and your Leases comprising important part all of Section 26 and the W/2 and SE/4 of Section 23 respectively, Township 17 North, Range 23 East, Leases Pennsylvania Pool, Lea County, New Mexico allocating the production to each lease on the basis of monthly well tests.

It is our understanding that each of the leases has a common working interest and that the royalty interest likewise is common being the common schools of the state of New Mexico.

Under the authority granted as pursuant to Rule 309-B, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

As you have requested, administrative order CTB-79 is hereby cancelled.

In compliance with your request of November 27, you are hereby granted permission to commingle the production from Philmex Lease, State Lease B2229, Section 26, T17S, R33E, Lea County, New Mexico, with the Leamex Lease, State Lease B2148, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, T17S, R33E, Lea County, New Mexico.

We have no objection to the proposal since all the acreage involved belongs to Common Schools of New Mexico; however, we feel that a reasonable close accounting should be kept on the production of each lease since they are being extended by production.
