Reference is made to your application dated March 1, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit Franklin, Aston & Fair, Inc. to commingle Red Lake (Grayburg-San Andres) production from State of New Mexico Lease No. B-7966 comprising the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 28 East and State of New Mexico Lease No. B-2071 comprising the W/2 SE/4 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests.
