Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated April 30, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your State of New Mexico "AN" Lease comprising the SE/4 of Section 6, Township 18 South, Range 15 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and your State of New Mexico "R" Lease comprising, in pertinent part, the NE/4 of said Section 6, insofar as the Vacuum Abo Reef Pool is concerned.

It is our understanding that each of these leases has a common working interest and that the royalty interest is also common throughout, and that therefore you propose to allocate the production to each of the leases on the basis of periodic well tests.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, you are hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of October 7, 1964, wherein you request authority to commingle Vacuum Glorieta and Vacuum Abo Reef production on your State of New Mexico "R" (NCT-1) and State of New Mexico "AB" Leases, comprising the NE/4 and SE/4, respectively, of Section 6, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately measuring the production from the Glorieta zone and determining the production from the Abo Reef zone by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that the ownership of each lease is identical throughout and that the production will be allocated to the respective leases on the basis of periodic tests.

Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) and 309-B of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools and leases in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. You are also requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.

Administrative Order CTB-106 which authorized the commingling of the Abo Reef production from the two leases is hereby cancelled.
