Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated May 2, 1963, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit Shell Oil Company to commingle the Lusk-Strown production from your Middleton "A" Lease comprising the W/2 SE/4 and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 30, and the N/2 NE/4 of Section 31, and your Middleton "B" Lease comprising the N/2 NW/4, SW/4 NW/4, S/2, and SE/4 NE/4 of Section 31, and your Keshane Lease comprising the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 31, and your Haskins Lease comprising the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 31, all in Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately and continuously metering the production from each lease.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, Shell Oil Company is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for temperature-compensated meters, samplers, and non-reset counters on the meters. Further, inasmuch as production has not yet been obtained from all of the aforesaid leases,
