Gentlemen:

It is hereby requested that administrative approval (Rule 309-B) be granted Shell to commingle production from the following leases in T16S, R32E, Lea County, New Mexico:

State MQC No. 2528	OG - 6014	NW/4 SE/4, Sec. 17
State MQD No. 2674	K - 867	SW/4, Sec. 17

Shell is the sole working interest owner of these leases and the State Common School Fund is the only royalty beneficiary. The only wells currently producing from this acreage are located on the State MQ and MQB leases and are completed in the Queen formation. Similar completions are anticipated on the other leases listed.


Approval to commingle at this time will allow more flexibility in the location of flowlines, tankage and treating facilities, and should result in a more economical exploitation of the reserves from these leases.

A location plat of the subject leases and a schematic diagram of the proposed metering and tankage facilities are attached. Further, in compliance with Paragraph 4, Rule 309-B, we are sending a copy of this letter by certified mail to the State Land Commissioner's Office and to the anticipated purchaser of the commingled production.


