
Administrative Order CTB-114

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated January 16, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of South Lane-Pennsylvanian production from that portion of State of New Mexico Lease No. E-9035 comprising the E/2 NW/4 of Section 26, and that portion of State of New Mexico Lease No. E-9796 comprising the W/2 SE/4 of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production to each lease on the basis of quarterly well tests. It is our understanding that both of the aforesaid leases are designated by T. F. Hodge as his Humble State "A" Lease, and that the ownership of each lease is common throughout, the royalty being dedicated to the improvement of the Rio Grande.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, T. F. Hodge is hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
