Dear Mr. Porter:

Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby submits application for the commingling of oil production from the Lusk Strawn Pool from various Plains Unit Wells until such time as these wells are included in a participating area for the Strawn production. Currently, Wells No. 2 and 3-X are completed and Wells No. 4-X and 5 are drilling. The only difference in ownership in these wells is an over-riding royalty interest.

These wells are located in Section 21 and 28, T-19-S, R-32-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of our request for exception approval without notice and hearing to Rule 309 (a) to permit commingling in common facilities of differently-owned production from a common source of supply, the following is submitted:

1. The oil production from each well having a difference in ownership will be measured separately utilizing A. O. Smith T-6 temperature compensated meters equipped with samplers.
2. A BS&W reading will be taken every eight days and the production from meter recorded.
3. The A. O. Smith T-6 meters will be proved monthly with a positive displacement master meter.
4. Schematic diagram of the proposed installation is attached. Tank battery facility to be located in the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 28, T-19-S, R-32-E.

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



We have submitted an application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission requesting administrative approval to commingle Stream Oil production from Plains Unit Wells No. 2, 3-X, 4-X, and 5 by metering, pending the establishment of a participating area. Two copies of this request are attached for your information.

Approval of this request will save the expense of installing separate tank battery facilities for Wells No. 4-X and No. 5 which are now drilling. If you have no objection to this method of handling this production, it will be appreciated if you will advise Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr. at Santa Fe.
