AMENDMENT

Administrative Order CTB-119

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Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of October 19, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-119 to include your State B-1501 Lease described as the W/2 SE/4 of Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the commingling authority contained therein.

Administrative Order CTB-119 at present authorizes the commingling of Vacuum-Grayburg production from your State B-1606 Lease comprising the NW/4 SW/4 and SW/4 NW/4 of Section 31 and your State B-1861 Lease comprising the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests inasmuch as the working interest and royalty interest is common throughout. It is our understanding that the ownership of your State B-1501 Lease is identical with the two previously authorized leases.

Administrative Order CTB-119 is hereby amended to include the State B-1501 Lease and Phillips Petroleum Company is authorized to commingle the Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres production from the three subject leases as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
