Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated June 30, 1964, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from the Vacuum Residue Pool on the following leases: State Lease No. B-1901 comprising the NW/4 of Section 3; State Lease No. B-2073 comprising the N/2 NE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 3; State Lease No. B-2131 comprising the N/2 NW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 4, all in Township 18 South, Range 15 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that each of these leases has a common working interest and the royalty interest is also common throughout, and that you therefore propose to allocate the production to each of the leases on the basis of periodic well tests.

Under the authority granted in pursuant to Rule 309 (b), you are hereby authorized to commingle the above-described production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."
