Gentlemen:

Your letter of August 18 requests our approval to commingle the Stream formation oil and gas produced from Tenneco Oil Company's well No. 1 USA-Trigg and No. 1 USA-Trigg "C" Unit. The wells are in the ~~SW 1/4~~ and ~~SE 1/4~~ sec. 4, T. 19 N., R. 12 E., Lea County, New Mexico, on leases New Mexico 0750-A and 0750, respectively.

The method of measurement and the system for commingling the oil and gas production as described by the schematic diagram attached to your letter, is hereby approved. Such approval is subject, however, to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and to the requirement that the production from the No. 1 USA-Trigg well will be allocated in accordance with the terms and provisions of communitization agreement No. Comm. Agr.-SN-127 and that the production from the No. 1 USA-Trigg "C" Unit well will be allocated in accordance with communitization agreement No. Comm. Agr.-SN-195.

You are also requested to notify the District Engineer, U. S. Geological Survey, P. O. Box 1157, Hobbs, New Mexico, when the installation is completed so that a field inspection of the facilities can be made.

Returned herewith are five copies of an instrument entitled "Agreement to Commingle Production." The agreement does not show our approval inasmuch as such approval is accomplished by this letter.
