O Reference is made to your letter of December 3, 1964, wherein you request an amendment to Administrative Order CTB-129 and which authorizes the commingling of Lusk-Strawn production on your USA-Continental Unit and USA-Continental "A" Unit in the E/2 of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that you wish to include your USA-Hudson Lease, comprising the NW/4 of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, in the commingling installation.

P Administrative Order CTB-129 is hereby amended to include the aforesaid USA-Hudson Lease, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," particularly Section III, Commingling Between Leases.
