Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of September 24, 1964, wherein you advise that you have now obtained an intermediate market for the Glorieta production previously commingled with the San Andres from your State A, State B, State F, and State H Leases, Vacuum Field, Lea County, New Mexico, and that you therefore plan to install a separate tank battery to handle the Glorieta production from the State A, State B, and State F Leases. Inasmuch as Commission Order R-1290-A authorized the commingling of the San Andres production from the aforesaid leases, this order is still in effect. You do, however, now desire the commingling authority for the Glorieta from the three above-mentioned leases. It is our understanding that the ownership of the leases is identical throughout.

Under the authority granted me pursuant to Rule 309-B, you are hereby authorized to commingle the aforesaid Glorieta production as proposed, subject to the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," allocating the production to each of the leases on the basis of periodic well tests. You are requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that a field inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.

Administrative Order PLC-6 is hereby cancelled.
