Reference is made to your application dated May 3, 1965, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil produced from your State of New Mexico OG 499 Lease which comprises the NW/4 and W/2 NE/4 of Section 34, and your State of New Mexico OG 961 Lease which comprises the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 10 South, Range 33 East, South Lane Pennsylvanian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
