

Gentlemen:

Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission grant administrative approval for exception to Rule 309-A whereby the Paddock production from our State "AE" (B-7766) and State "AH" (E-1678) lease can be commingled. Both of the above leases are producing from the Lovington Paddock Pool and are located in Sections 35-36-T16S-R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The following information is given in support of this application:

- (1) The State "AE" and State "AH" lease are now known as the State "AE" Lease.
- (2) Lease production will not be measured separately before commingling as the ownership of the leases is common throughout. The State of New Mexico is the royalty owner and Cities Service Oil Company is the working interest owner.
- (3) All production to be commingled into this common tank battery will be from the Paddock formation.
- (4) Adequate facilities will be provided for accurately determining production from each well at reasonable intervals.
- (5) All parties owning an interest in the leases and the purchaser of the commingled production therefrom have been notified by registered mail of the interest to commingling of production from the separate leases. A mailing list is attached.
- (6) A plat of the leases showing the wells thereon and a schematic diagram of the commingling facility are attached.



SECTION 35 & 36 TOWNSHIP 16S RANGE 36E COUNTY LEA STATE NEW MEXICO


